C7 Gm7

Won't you change par - tners and dance with me?

Ab Cm7
Ask him to sit this one out and while you're alone
Ab C7 Bb F C7
I'll tell the waiter to tell him he's wanted on the tele-phone

You've been locked in his arms
C7 Gm7
Ever since heaven-knows-when
Bbm6 F Db7 C7 Cm6 D7
