F **F7** **Bb** **Bbm6**
Another sunny honeymoon,
F **Dm7** **Db7** **C7**
Another season, another reason for makin
F **Abdim** **Gm7** **C7**
Whoopee!

F **F#dim** **Gm7** **C7**
A lot of shoes, a lot of rice,
F **F7** **Bb** **Bbm6**
The groom is nervous, he answers twice,
F **Dm7** **Db7**
It's really killing that he's so willing
C7 **F** **Bbm6** **F**
To make whoopee!

Ebdim **Gm**
Picture a little love nest
Bbm6 **F**
Down where the roses cling.
Ebdim **Gm**
Picture the same sweet love nest,
Bbm6 **F** **Caug**
Think what a year can bring.

F **F#dim** **Gm7** **C7**
He's washing dishes and baby clothes,
F **F7** **Bb** **Bbm6**
He's so ambitious he even sews.
F **Dm7** **Db7**
But don't forget, folks, That's what you get, folks,
C7 **F** **Abdim** **Gm7** **C7** **F** **Bbm6** **F ... F6**
For makin' whoopee! Another whoopee!
