## Verse 1:

[D] All the [A+] old gang [D7] I once knew  
[G] Now have left me [Gm6] two by two  
The [D] old neighbour [F#m7b5]hood don't [B7] look so good  
[E7] I'm so [E13] lonely [A9] by my only [A+]

[D] Each and [A+] every [D7] one it seems  
[G] Meets the ideal [Gm6] of their dreams,  
I've [D] searched every [F#m7b5] where for [B7] my ideal  
[E7] Now I'm beginning to [A7] feel [F#dim] [A7]

## Chorus:

[D] Nobody [B7] knows, [E7] nobody [A7] cares  
If I'm [D] lonesome [F#dim] [Em7] [A7] [A+]  
[D] Nobody [B7] sighs, [E7] nobody [A7] cries  
If I'm [D] blue

It [D7] seems that [G] night after night  
[Gm] I sit alone and [D] twiddle my [F#m] thumbs  
[Bm] But [Edim] still [Bm7] I [E7] keep right on hoping,  
[E7inv] Keep the door open but [A7] nobody comes [A+]

[D] Ain't it a [B7] crime, [E7] kisses of [A7] mine  
Are just [D] wasted [F#dim] [Em7] [A7] [A+]  
[D7] Since I'm a tot, I'm singin' what'll  
[D+] I [G] do, (boo-hoo)

[B+] Like a [G] plaything on the [Bb7] shelf,  
[D] Guess [A+] I'll [D] have to [Fdim] be by myself  
'Cause [D] nobody [B7] knows, [E7] nobody [A7] cares  
If I'm [D] blue [F#dim] [E7] [A7] [A+]

## Verse 2:

[D] Life must [A+] be a [D7] lot of fun  
[G] When two hearts beat [Gm6] just as one.  
There's [D] never a [F#m7b5] care when [B7] there's a pair  
[E7] Of eyes [E13] for you, [A9] that adore you [A+]

[D] I keep [A+] trying [D7] constantly  
[G] To meet someone [Gm6] meant for me, but  
[D] try as I [F#m7b5] may it's [B7] strange to say  
[E7] Nobody happens my [A7] way [F#dim] [A7]
